- Robert spoke about how schools are really stepping up to the plate when it comes to covid-19
 protocols. The superintendent toured the schools to discuss re-entry plans and was impressed
 by the schools responses. We need to know that if covid-19 enters into a school population that
 it is AHS that will set out the response necessary. The mission is to keep kids safely in school.
- The budget was looking like a huge deficit would have to be dealt with(570,000) but then the government was able to provide some covid financial relief. A welcome sight. There is much work to be done as far as maintenance and such so the budget will be monitored
